*Some simple rules* to follow when dealing with exam questions

1. Read all questions first. Identify those that you are (or at least you think you are) most comfortable with. Deal with these questions first.
2. Read the question. Then read it again. Try to understand, what is given, what is being asked. Think. Identify the relevant QM model. If you think you know the answer, think again. (As a rule, thinking helps...)
3. Make sure your answers/solutions are legible. After you finished answering a question, read your answer.
4. Identify the next least difficult question. Go to line 2. If there are no unanswered questions remaining, go to line 5.
5. If time permits, it is advisable to re-read all your answers before handing in the exam sheets.
